I am grateful to Piers Nicholson, Past Master Tyler and Bricklayer, whose initiative and hard work this has been. And also to Mark Grove and *The Cook and The Butler* whose sponsorship has paid for the printing.

The earlier editions were published to coincide with the annual Ironbridge livery weekend, but the timing of this edition allows a complete record of all the Masters for the year 2013-14, including of course the majority who were installed around July and October.

Another website which I hope will be of interest/use to you is www.liverlycommittee.org where details of the various courses and briefings organised by the Livery Committee may be found, and bookings made on line. In particular I would draw your attention to the **City Briefings** held at Guildhall in the early evening four times a year. These are designed to be relevant to all involved in livery companies, from the newest joined Freeman, to Court Assistants, Wardens, and indeed Masters and their Clerks; their spouses and partners are also welcome. Please may I ask Masters and Clerks to nominate or encourage your Liverymen to attend one of these briefings as part of their induction into your company or court.

The role of the Livery Committee includes acting as the conduit for communication between the livery (and its Masters, Prime Wardens, Courts, Liverymen and Clerks) and the "powers that be" at Guildhall (including the Chamberlain's Court), Mansion House, and the Old Bailey, *on any matter affecting the interests of the general body of the Livery* (to quote from our terms of reference drafted in 1942). The committee is also now a means of improving communications between the Corporation and the Livery, increasing the involvement of Liverymen in City affairs, and acting as a forum for discussion.
